

# PATIENT QUICK CHECKLIST

## Take your Tikosyn each day the way your doctor tells you

- Most patients take one capsule twice a day
- Do not miss a dose or take an extra dose
- Go for all your regular checkups
- Get your refills on time
- Do not stop taking Tikosyn until your doctor tells you to stop
- Do not use it for any other condition or give it to others

## Tell your doctor and pharmacist the names of all medications you are taking

- Prescription and Nonprescription
- Natural/herbal remedies
- Vitamins and Dietary supplements

Do not start to take any new medicines without telling your doctor.

## Call your doctor right away if you

- Feel faint
- Become dizzy
- Have fast heartbeats

These symptoms can be quite serious. And in rare instances, they can cause death.

## What are the possible side effects of Tikosyn?

- The most serious side effect is a dangerous abnormal heartbeat (You may feel lightheaded or faint)
- The most common side effects are headache, chest pain, and dizziness
- If you take Tikosyn along with some other medicines, the chance that you will get the abnormal heartbeat is greater

## **DO NOT TAKE:**

- cimetidine (Tagamet®, Tagamet® HB)\*
- verapamil (Calan®, Calan® SR, Covera-HS®, Isoptin®, Isoptin® SR, Verelan®, or Verelan® PM)\*
- ketoconazole (Nizoral®)\*
- prochlorperazine (Compazine®)\*
- trimethoprim alone (Proloprim®, Trimplex®)\* or in combination with sulfamethoxazole (Bactrim®, Septra®)\*
- megestrol (Megace®)\*
- hydrochlorothiazide alone or in combination with other medicines (such as Esidrix®, Ezide®, HydroDIURIL®, Hydro-Par®, Microzide™, or Oretic®)\*
